



## Cancer Survivor's Park

Out of more than 20 submissions, Clark Dixon unanimously won a competition sponsored by the Memphis Urban Art Commission to design a cancer survivor park within Audubon Park in East Memphis. Throughout, natural landscaping and a meaningful hardscape combine with commissioned artwork to create an overall space that is intended to encourage, inspire and celebrate survivorship. The park is one of 23 built in cities nationwide by a grant from the R. A. Bloch Cancer Foundation.
