



Chucalissa Archeological Museum

As part of Chucalissa's overall master plan, Clark Dixon rebuilt the eroding riverbank using concrete-filled burlap bags, which is a more traditional, historically accurate method, and restored and stabilized an excavation trench dug by Memphis State University. Extremely sensitive and meticulous methods had to be used throughout both projects, particularly the excavation trench, as prehistoric Indian artifacts were unearthed throughout the process.
